

The Center is **a place of solidarity** which offers a listening ear, help with various procedures, referrals, community meals, mutual support, collective action and educational, social and cultural activities. In all these ways, we work to combat poverty, exclusion and violence, and fight for the improvement of our lives. It is also a space where people can get involved as volunteers if they wish to.

Only our activities with mandatory sign-ups are reserved for members only, otherwise anyone is welcome. Becoming a member is free. A voluntary contribution is possible.







Please note that **people can generally be greeted in French, English, or Spanish during our drop-in hours.** For activities, available languages are indicated in our programming depending on our translation capacities.

(FR = French, ENG = English, SP = Spanish)






DANCE

FEMINIST SELF-DEFENSE PROGRAM

The Center offers a physical, psychological, and verbal selfdefense course given by the **Réseau d'Autodéfense Féministe** (RAF).

The program includes a mix of physical exercises and discussions, and touches on themes such as the basics of self-defense, our personal limits and boundaries, emotional violence and street harassment.

This fall, the program will be offered in English.
